# English Entry Methods and Requirements.

To study at BPP University, you will need to provide evidence of your English language ability to meet the entry requirements of your chosen degree programme, and to comply with UKVI requirements.

You may be exempt from evidencing your English language ability:

- 1. If you are a national of a majority English speaking country under Appendix 1(2)
- 2. If you have completed a degree as a resident taught in a majority English speaking country under Appendix 1(1) of this document.
- 3. If you have studied at one of the institutions listed on BPP's medium of instruction vouch list under Appendix 2.

Methods of proving English language proficiency:

- 4. Proof of a degree from a distance learning programme taught and examined in English and delivered from a majority English speaking country or an overseas campus of a UK higher education institute, and achieving the required score in an English language speaking test with an ELT (English Language Test) assessor. Please note, you must have graduated within **five years** of the start date of the programme at BPP University.
- 5. Relevant scores in one of the English language qualifications listed below. This must have been completed within two years of the start of your programme at BPP University and all results must be issued on the same certificate.

BPP will only consider English evidence with a **10-year** maximum validity unless otherwise specified by BPP or the issuer of a Secure English Language Test (SELT).

Any evidence exceeding the validity period will not be accepted and the applicant will be required to conduct another assessment, either an accepted SELT or BPP's English Language Test.

# **Additional Requirements by Programme**

# **Barrister Training Course (BTC) (all variants)**

Candidates who hold or will hold by the time of admission to the Barrister Training Course, a UK bachelor's degree, master's degree or doctorate which required at least one academic year of study as a resident in the UK may be exempt from demonstrating English language proficiency via a SELT certificate.

Candidates who hold or will hold by the time of admission to the BTC a UK bachelor's degree, master's degree or doctorate which was taught and examined in English in a majority-English speaking country under Appendix 1(1) of this document, including those taught and examined in English at an overseas campus of a relevant UK Higher education institution, must pass a BPP Test (Speaking and Listening) with a minimum of 7.5 in each skill.

Candidates for the BTC programme who do not meet the above criteria must demonstrate that they meet the requirements of 7.5 in IELTS or equivalent for each skill. Entry methods for this course include:

- 1. IELTS with 7.5 minimum in each component
- 2. The equivalent score in Pearson PTE (73 minimum in each component and overall)
- 3. The equivalent score in BPP's English Language Test

## **BSc (Hons) Nursing [Pre-registration Nursing] Programmes**

Applicants will be required to complete an additional assessment with BPP's School of Nursing to assess their knowledge of medical English. This is in addition to meeting the English entry requirement as listed previously.



# **Alternative Accepted English Entry Methods by Nation**

This section outlines additional accepted English Entry Methods for applicants from specific nations. BPP has researched and confirmed that these qualifications are equivalent to its entry requirements and are of a standard that allows BPP to comply with its UKVI Sponsor Duties.

### **Hong Kong**

BPP accepts the Hong Kong Diploma in Secondary Education (HKDSE).

Required grades and their equivalencies for the HKDSE are as follows:

The HKDSE qualification can be used as English entry evidence for all programmes **except the Barrister Training Courses** as it does not meet the entry requirements for these programmes.

### **India and Nepal**

BPP will assess applicants from India and Nepal based on their Higher Secondary School Certificate and Higher Secondary Education Board Examination, hereby referred to as HSSC.

Applicants applying for **MSc Management (all variants), MSc Accounting and Finance, MSc Healthcare Leadership** who have achieved 60% or more in their HSSC English, and have completed a Bachelor's degree course in English, are deemed by BPP to meet the English language requirements for their respective programmes. If an applicant does not have a mark of 60% or more, they will be required to take a Speaking and Listening Orientation with BPP.

Should an applicant fail to reach the required level in the orientation, they may be able to re-apply for the next available intake for reassessment.

Applicants applying for **BSc Accounting and Finance, BSc Accounting and Finance with Digital Business** (but have not previously completed a Bachelor's course taught in English) who have achieved 60% or more in their HSSC English are deemed by BPP to meet the English language requirements for their respective courses. If an applicant has a mark of less than 60%, they will be required to take a full ELT with BPP.

Should an applicant fail to reach the required level in the BPP ELT, they may be able to re-apply for the next available intake for reassessment.

This English entry method is only available for the programmes listed above and cannot be used for any **BPP Law programmes or BSc Nursing**.

### Malaysia

BPP accepts the **Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) (1119 syllabus)** qualification if taken and issued before the 2021 session and syllabus. The SPM results document must specifically state '1119' or BPP will not accept this as evidence of you satisfying the English entry requirements.

Required grades and their equivalencies for the SPM are as follows:

The SPM qualification can be used as English entry evidence for all programmes **except the Barrister Training Courses** as it does not meet the entry requirements for these programmes.

### **West Africa**

BPP accepts a range of English assessments from West Africa to satisfy its English requirement validation. BPP defines West Africa to include **The Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Liberia, Nigeria,** and **Sierra Leone**.



# WASSC, WAEC, NECO

BPP accepts the West African Senior School Certificate (WASSC), West Africa Examination Council, and National Examinations Council certifications.

Required grades and their equivalencies for these certificates are as follows:

The WASSCE, WAEC and NECO qualifications can be used as English entry evidence for all programmes **except the Barrister Training Courses** as it does not meet the entry requirements for these programmes.

The 10-year validity requirement does not apply to these qualifications following BPP's own investigation and market research.
