Questions 2.19 and 2.20	<p>The solutions to 2.20 contain additional feedback for 2.19; the feedback for 2.20 should read as follows:</p> <p>Responses to address each risk are the most likely addition to C's risk register. Timescales are possible but not as likely as responses. Sponsors are too high level to put in the risk register while insurance is also incorrect as not every will be addressed by insurance.</p>
Question 3.2	<p>Within the answers, the feedback to this question suggests that a review of the marketplace will not address changes to the digital landscape.</p> <p><b>This is incorrect</b> and should read:</p> <p>'The other options will not address changes to the digital landscape (eg streaming to portable devices).'</p> <p>All other information is correct.</p>
Question 3.19	<p>Within the question, there should be a more explicit link between having dirty engines which fail the emissions test and the longer term reputation of Company V - consequently, to restore its reputation, the <b>most important thing the company needs to do in the long term</b> is address the dirty engines.</p> <p>All other information is correct.</p>
Question 6.17	<p>Within the question, the <b>requirement</b> should ask:</p> <p>'Which of the following options represents the most appropriate approach to changing its systems?'</p> <p>All other information is correct.</p>
